## **eValuator Encounter Search Functionality**



- The Encounter Search box is located on the bottom of the eValuator home screen.
- Enter encounter number in the search box and select 'search'.
- · Search options..
  - Exact match automatically selected. If selected, will look for exact encounter number match. If not selected, will return encounter numbers that start with number entered in search box.
  - In a workpool only automatically selected. If selected, will only search for encounters that are in a workpool. If not selected, will search for all encounters in eValuator.



- · The encounter search will return encounter with following information..
  - Facility The facility the encounters is in.
  - · Workpool The workpool the encounter is located in.
  - Stage The stage within the workpool the encounter is in (audit, coder, complete).
  - Reserved To If encounter is assigned to somebody, their name will be populated in the reserved to column.
  - Started Date/time the audit was started.
- Once the search returns the desired encounter you will have the option to select..
  - Audit Select 'Audit' to open encounter in Audit mode. This will also result in the encounter being reserved to you.
  - View Select 'view' to open encounter in view only mode.
  - Audit History Select 'Audit History' to open the audit history of the encounter.
  - Move Encounter Select this option to move the encounter to a different workpool within the same facility.
- If encounter is not found in eValuator, you will receive 'No data found' message.
  - User can review to ensure encounter number is entered correctly, or modify search options by unchecking the 'in a workpool only' option.
